

<p>English</p>  	<p>The children will continue to work in their small Read Write phonics groups for an hour every morning. They will learn and practise different phonic sounds every day before reading and writing words containing these sounds. The children will come home with cards, sheets or books which they would love to share with you at home. The faster the children pick up the phonic sounds, the quicker they will be able to read and write, so your support at home is extremely valuable and important. As well as phonic and English sessions, the children will be reading every day in guided sessions. This year great emphasis will be placed on neat presentation of work and all children will be encouraged to form their letters correctly, as this is very important when children start to join up their writing in Year 2.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>This term the children will be looking at the value of numbers. They will be looking at the place value of numbers within 10 and addition and subtraction of numbers within 10. They will be representing numbers and sorting in different ways and developing their ability to count forwards and backwards.</p>
<p>Science</p>  <p>VISION HEARING SMELL TASTE TOUCH</p>	<p>In science the children will be naming different parts of the human body and learning about the different senses (smelling, tasting, touching, hearing and seeing). They will also be talking about changes in the weather and the seasons.</p>
<p>Topic</p> 	<p>In History the children will become historians as they learn about childhood and how it has changed over time, from toy crazes to schools to homes. If you have any old toys at your home that you or your parents played with, we would love to borrow/see them.</p>
<p>Home School Partnership</p> 	<p>We would like you to help your child at home with the following activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• listen to your child read at least 3 times every week and then discuss what has been read to develop their understanding• practise letter formation• practise counting forwards and backwards
<p>Reminders</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading books and reading record books should be in school every day.• PE is on a Tuesday morning so please could you send your child to school dressed ready for their PE session in trainers/pumps, jogging bottoms, PE T-shirt and school jumper.
