However, we will consider all online responses that are completed during the inspection, although the free-text box facility will not be available after noon on the final on-site day of the inspection.

During the inspection, the inspectors will collect information about staff and children at the school by talking to them, looking at school documents, responses to the pupil and staff surveys, where appropriate, and observing the everyday life at the school. In most cases, we do not record names. However, some of the information may make it possible to identify a particular individual. Ofsted will not publish any information that identifies an individual in the report but may name the headteacher and the chair of the appropriate authority.
