Our Halloween Disco this year will take place on the first Monday back at school after the half term break, from 4-5pm that evening.

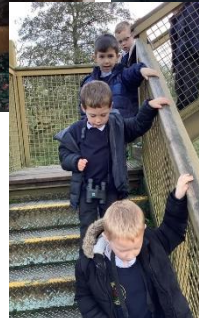
This means that children will be able to go to the disco on Monday evening (30th) and then go 'trick or treating' on Tuesday evening (31st).
